CRAFT ALES

As is befitting for a hostelry that has long enjoyed a reputation as a purveyor of fine ales, now that this restaurant has been upgraded we mustn't lose sight of the great compliment that ale offers food. 6 Belgian styled, Scottish brewed bottles have been chosen for your delectation. These are brewed at the Six Degrees North Brewery in Laurencekirk by Ari Rovati – "Brewer of the Year" in The Scottish Beer Awards 2016 (Six Degrees North = 6°N of Brussels!)

| 28 Hopocrisy Blonde 4.6% abv | £4.95 | |
| This is the baby brother of Hop Classic with the same hops used. A benchmark introduction to the range, with fresh hoppy aromas and a touch of Madeira cake sweetness and apricot. | | |
| 29 Wanderlust Wheat 4.6% abv | £4.95 | |
| A traditional Belgian Wit style with the addition of dried Curacao, orange peel and ground coriander seeds. Typically cloudy and white like a good wheat beer should be. Lustful creamy aromas bounce around with orange citrus, coriander seed, barley sugar and macadamia nut. | | |
| 30 Four Seasons 6.0% abv | £5.95 | |
| Saison is a traditional Farmhouse style which was originally brewed in the winter months, then given to the 'Saisonnieres' (season farm workers) in the hot months. Historically a 3% beer and up to 5 litres drunk a day by the farms hands! The Saison yeast is very important in the brewing process, providing dryness, spice and character. | | |
| 31 Hop Classic 6.6% abv | £5.95 | |
| A fairly new type of style to Belgium with the focus on hops. This makes a refreshing counterpart to UK IPAs which have become popular. We prefer to use noble hops with lower alpha acid to provide aromatic and complex flavours. | | |
| 32 Chopper Stout 7.0% abv | £5.95 | |
| Chopper is a classic Belgian style stout; The difference being it is stronger at 7% and is ultimately cleaner in style. With chopper you still retain the malty, chocolate vibe with the added drinkability. Silky black magic! | | |
| 33 Honey 'Bee' Good 6.0% abv | £5.95 | |
| A cracking style of beer made with heather honey. The honey acts to support the aromas of mango and citrus pith along with a touch of malty sweetness. | | |
